Linda, Leo & Lions Club

Meet Linda and Leo, Service Team #629. These two graduated from the KSDS Service Program in the spring. Linda suffers from Multiple Sclerosis (MS) or more specifically secondary progressive MS.

Upon arriving on campus, Linda was excited yet anxious for the opportunity to meet her new fur-ever partner. "I was pretty nervous getting ready for the trip, but it was incredible," she explained.

"Leo has responded so well to me...I am a little slower when I walk due to my MS, but I've noticed he mimics my slower movements, and it is just amazing. It was just incredible to see how well we bonded over just a few weeks."

Many commonly think of how the name "Leo" stems from the Latin word lion and dates back centuries. In German, however,

"Leo" serves as a short version of Leon or Leopold, which means "brave people" or "lion-hearted."

After a few short months of returning home together as a team, both Linda and Leo are learning to be lion-hearted. Besides navigating the world as a new team together, they are enduring the sudden passing of Linda's husband David Eaton.

"It has been difficult...for both of us. Dave tried hard not to bond with Leo, but they did. We both needed a little space at first," she said.

Leo was named by the Washington Lions Club who held fundraisers to sponsor a puppy name. The donation received from this club is just one example of the tremendous support KSDS receives from Lions Clubs across the state of Kansas and surrounding states.

The Lions organization's founding mission is to serve the blind. Although Leo is not assisting a blind or visually impaired individual, he is still serving someone in need. And his job has only become increasingly important.

"My loved ones keep telling me it was like Dave knew I was going to be okay now that I had Leo."

Linda & Leo graduated in April of 2023 and returned home as Service Team #629.

Glorybee All Flags Flyin' "Banner" - Born 10-24-86 Banner was one of the first dogs donated to KSDS for the breeding program. He helped establish one of the finest breeding programs in the United States. "Banner Park" on the West side of the Administration Building was dedicated in his honor in June 1997.

In the Whelping Wing of the Canine Housing Unit, a picture of a single Golden Retriever hangs framed on the wall. In the top corner of the picture is a plaque with the above inscribed.

What was once the finest breeding program in the U.S. has now become part of an international breeding cooperative. To date, KSDS has shared breeding stock with similar organizations in four countries on three continents: Canada, Ireland, Australia & Croatia.

In an effort to further honor Banner's legacy, KSDS has been working to upgrade Banner Park. Initially, the park was built to be utilized as training grounds and double as a play area for dogs in training and visiting teams or puppy raisers. The proposed renovation project aims to improve the training park's infrastructure, accessibility, overall functionality and appearance.

A new cement retaining wall, curved and sharp angled sidewalks, and concrete steps have already been installed. KSDS would like to thank Chuck Walter and SunDance Concrete for their work on the new retaining wall and cement floor.

New fencing is to be installed to secure the perimeter of the park, along with shade structures to provide relief from the summer sun. We anticipate using lumber, PVC pipe, and acrylic panels to construct obstacles, overhangs, removable ground panels and a raised platform with a staircase on each side. Banner Park will also be covered in artificial turf opposed to the current pea gravel covering the ground.

Like the play yard in the Canine Housing Unit, the pea gravel became an issue. Some dogs would eat the small rocks. The bigger issue is accessbility. With the installation of artificial turf, those in wheelchairs will have easier access to the entire park area. Besides the cosmetic benefits, the electronic sign will also be an asset in training guide, service and facility canines. With its tall structure and lights, trainers will utilize the sign as a distraction when walking dogs in their guide harness or service cape.

We will also be able to utilize the sign for informational purposes when hosting campus events like graduation or Pups Days.

We have set a goal for summer of 2024 as the completion date. The estimated cost of the Banner Park upgrades is \$100,000. KSDS has requested consideration for a grant to be used towards the renovations.

The new Banner Park Training Course will improve the quality of assistance dogs being placed with KSDS clients, enhance the overall curbside appeal of the campus and provide an opportunity for visitors to witness firsthand KSDS staff working with assistance dogs in training.

Additionally, electronic signage will be installed a few feet away from the new park and along highway 36. Along with the bright green turf, the signage will draw significant attention to the KSDS campus and improve the entire community's curb appeal. Since we are in a rural community but sit along a major state highway, KSDS relies on our curbside image to draw in visitors to our campus.
