## LIFE Center Blends Generations—and Brings Smiles with Buster

At the heart of the Logan Intergenerational Family Education (LIFE) Center, generations connect in meaningful, daily ways. This pioneering facility combines a community-centered care, a 36-bed “small house” style nursing home, a Pre-K through 4th grade elementary school, a day care center, and a variety of shared amenities—all under one roof.

The LIFE Center is more than just a place to live or learn—it’s a place to belong. Children and senior residents share music, meals, and play, forming natural bonds that boost joy, reduce loneliness, and foster empathy. One four-legged newcomer is especially good at bringing people together: Buster, a black Labrador and newly minted facility dog. He recently joined the team with Logan Manor administrator Teresa McComb, who says his calming presence has been transformative.

Buster not only accompanies residents to medical appointments, offering comfort and familiarity, but he’s also a daily favorite among both young students and elders. One resident living with dementia, who struggles with most names, greets Buster with a smile and his name each morning—a small moment with a big impact. Children love to snuggle him on the floor, and Buster takes it all in stride, patiently bridging generational gaps with wagging-tail warmth.

The LIFE Center’s innovative model is gaining attention nationwide for its deeply human approach to elder and youth care. With support from staff like Teresa and the daily magic of Buster, it’s clear that connection, care, and community are thriving at Logan.

## From 4-H Roots to National Impact

This year, **KSDS Assistance Dogs, Inc** is proud to celebrate **35 years** of empowering **independence and transforming lives** through the incredible bond between people and dogs. What began in 1990 as a small group of 4-H Dog Project puppy raisers and their families has grown into a nationwide mission.

Thanks to the unwavering dedication of volunteers, donors, trainers, and staff, **KSDS has placed 659 guide, service, and facility dog teams** across **37 states**, with **puppy raisers in 23 states** helping raise the next generation of canine partners.

## A Mission Rooted in Family

KSDS began as Kansas Specialty Dog Services with a clear, heartfelt mission: to promote the independence and inclusion of people with disabilities. The organization was founded by four Kansas families deeply involved in 4-H who had firsthand experience raising puppies for another assistance dog organization. Recognizing a critical need for placements closer to home in the Midwest, they took the leap and formed a local organization to serve their community and beyond.

It was the first organization in the United States to raise and train guide, service, and facility dogs at the same location, showcasing its innovative spirit and dedication to the cause.
